The Box Tops for Education program is changing the way we can earn cash for Pine Hill School! You may have noticed that over the summer, participating brands began to



change their packaging from the traditional Box Tops clip to the new Box Tops label. Going forward, instead of clipping from packages and checking expiration dates, all Box Tops will be earned digitally by scanning your store receipt using the new-and-improved Box Tops mobile app, available now. The new app enables you to scan your store receipt, find participating products and instantly add Box Tops to our school's earnings online. **Be sure to download the new app or update your existing app today!** Please include your child's name and classroom when submitting on line in the 'credit' field.

If you still have traditional Box Tops clips at home, make sure to send them into school, in an envelope marked with your child's name and teacher's name. We will still earn cash for all clipped Box Tops until they expire. And better yet, you can "double dip" during the packaging transition by clipping traditional Box Tops AND scanning your store receipt containing participating products.


